This day-and-a-half training will cover a broad range of issues through practical workshops and lectures. It will address the Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU) jurisprudence in the field of Sports Law, the jurisdiction of international and national bodies in the exercise of disciplinary powers and its control by national courts, the image rights of athletes, the impact of migration in sports law, online betting, and the prevention and administrative control of sporting

events. Participants are expected to have some background knowledge of the subject and to engage in active discussions with their counterparts from across the EU. This training seeks to operate as a platform for the exchange of knowledge and best practices among colleagues, the debate of key developments in this field, and the creation of lasting networks of judicial cooperation and understanding.
